The Government of the Republic of Malawi intends to apply for financing in the amount of US\$ 115 Million equivalent from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of the Lilongwe Water and Sanitation Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project.

- iii) Component 3-Priority Sanitation Improvements.
- iv) Component 4-Technical Assistance.
- v) Component 5-Institutional Capacity Strengthening.

c) Non-Consultancy Services

Procurement of contracts financed by the World Bank will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016 (Procurement Regulations), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the regulations.

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the World Bank's open-international procedures will be announced, as they become available, in UN Development Business, deMarket, LWB website and in local newspapers.

Works and Services to be procured under Open-International bidding procedures are as follows:

- Water Supply Network Expansion in Lilongwe City (Distribution pipes, Transport pipes, Reservoirs and Pumping Stations).

 Rehabilitation and Expansion and Packaging of a Performance
 Based Non-Revenue Water Reduction Program.
- ii) Preparation of a Water Supply Master Plan for Lilongwe City.
- Consultancy Service for Development of a Sanitation Master Plan for Lilongwe City and Design of Priority Sanitation Interventions.
- iv) Construction Supervision of Sanitation Priority Improvements –

- Revenue Collection Mechanisms Study and Operationalization of Sanitation Tariff.
- vi) Consultancy Services for Groundwater Assessment and Mapping,
