

**Feed the Future Malawi Agricultural  
Diversification Activity  
Solicitation for the Supply of Irrigation  
Technology Equipment**

Palladium International LLC is implementing a five-year USAID funded Feed the Future Malawi Agriculture Diversification Activity. The Activity is designed to contribute to USAID/Malawi's Feed the Future goal of sustainably reducing poverty and stunting in eight districts of Central and Southern Malawi: Mchinji, Dedza, Ntcheu, Balaka, Machinga, Mangochi, Lilongwe rural and Blantyre rural. Palladium is seeking to prequalify interested dealers, companies or organisations for the supply of Irrigation Technology Equipment - Irrigation Water rollers, Simple Manual Irrigation Pump and Solar Powered Irrigation Pump. The irrigation technology equipment will improve smallholder farmers efficiency in water transport and irrigating backyard gardens.

- Proof of prior experience (past contracts, purchase orders) and references of supplies done within the last 3 years.
- Warranty / guarantee minimum 12 months
- Estimated costs for each item and associated components etc. Bidders may bid for a single lot, multiple or all of them provided they are bidding for a full quantity for each lot. Evaluation will be based per lot.
- Payment plan – the activity will only process payment upon final delivery and acceptance of services and supplies.
- Bidders are free to quote for a single lot, any combination or all of them provided they are quoting for a full quantity of the lot.
