Malawi delegate to participate in Raisina Dialogue 2018

The Raisina Dialogue is a multilateral flagship conference organized by Observer Research Foundation in collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India in areas of geopolitics and geo-economics. The organization hosts global leaders in policy, business, media and civil society in New Delhi, every year. The Dialogue is structured as a multi-stakeholder, cross-sectoral discussion, involving Heads of State, Cabinet Ministers and local government officials, as well as major private sector executives, members of the media and academics. The third edition of the Raisina Dialogue will take place in New Delhi from 16-18 January 2018 and the theme of conference is “Managing Disruptive Transitions: ideas, institutions and idioms”.

The Raisina Dialogue is a prestigious event which is inaugurated by the Prime Minister of India and attracts large participation from former Heads of State and Governments, Foreign Ministers, senior diplomats/officials, prominent academicians, and business leaders, among others.
