

INVITATION TO TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND FULL COMMISSIONING OF 18 ART (ANTIRETROVIRAL TREATMENT) PRE-FABRICATED CLINICS IN ZOMBA DISTRICT - MALAWI

EQUIP is a programme that supports a number of countries to achieve their UNAIDS 90-90-90 targets through a tiered integrated strategy of Direct Service Delivery and Technical Assistance. EQUIP in Malawi started in 2016 and is being led by Right to Care. Through our implementing partners we support the comprehensive rapid scale up of HIV care and treatment services in 245 facilities across fifteen districts in Malawi.

One of the barriers to providing quality HIV services in some facilities is the lack of adequate and appropriate infrastructure. EQUIP is, therefore, inviting tenders for suppliers to install and commission eighteen (18) prefabricated units which will be used to provide HIV services – both testing and treatment – in 18 facilities in Zomba, Malawi.

The scope of this project includes the design, site preparation, transport to sites and on-site installation and full commission of the project.
