India Celebrates 72nd Independence Day

The High Commission of India, Lilongwe celebrated the 72nd Independence Day of India on 15th August 2018. The programme began by hoisting of the Indian Flag by the High Commissioner which was followed by the singing of the Indian National Anthem. Shortly after the anthem, the High Commissioner of India to Malawi, H.E Shri Suresh Kumar Menon then proceeded to reading the President of India's message to the Nation. He subsequently addressed the large Indian community gathered on the occasion. A cultural dance troupe from the State of Rajasthani performed a variety of Indian songs and dances. This was followed by members of the Indian community who sang patriotic songs. The programme concluded with a Yoga demonstration by Teacher of Indian Culture.

The Indian National Day was marked by an evening reception at the High Commissioner's residence. The Minister of Education, Science and Technology, Hon. Bright Msaka (MP) was Guest of Honor and Head of Missions, the Diplomatic Community and members of International Organizations graced the occasion.
